

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Results highlight (consolidated)



- 2Q sales down 14.3% YoY to 608 million yen due to the June 5 ransomware incident
- Gross profit down 65.2% YoY to 118 million yen due to lower sales and an increase in IDC expenses
- Operating loss was 174 million yen, down 221 million yen YoY from an operating profit one year earlier
- Steady revenue from the Shalom Business down 17.0% YoY to 416 million yen partially due to the suspension of some invoicing in June and July
- Order backlog in the CuBe Business decreased 15.9% from the end of the previous fiscal year to 237 million yen

Financial summary (consolidated)



2Q sales were down 14.3% YoY to 608 million yen because of the ransomware incident. Ransomware was also responsible for 2Q operating loss of 174 million yen.

Cash flows from operating activities decreased 652 million yen YoY because of deterioration in business performance.




2Q consolidated sales decreased 14.3% YoY due to the ransomware incident



Gross profit (consolidated)




Gross profit down 65.2% YoY due to a decrease in sales caused by the ransomware incident and higher IDC expenses. Gross margin decreased 28.5pt compared with the same period a year earlier.



Operating profit (consolidated)



Operating loss was 174 million yen, a decrease of 221 million yen from an operating profit one year earlier due to decreases in sales and gross profit.






The number of employees decreased due to an increase in retired employees despite a continuation of hiring new college graduates






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Personnel and promotion expenses (consolidated)

Prioritized recruitment to strengthen sales and development systems.






IDC and software amortization expenses (consolidated)




Both 2Q steady revenue and other sales significantly decreased due to the ransomware incident

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Expect higher earnings in FY3/24 due to the large volume of orders in the fiscal year's second half.




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FOREVER – The new Shalom Project



Development work has started on FOREVER, a system that will follow Shalom V5.0.

Transition of Shalom and FOREVER

Sales of Shalom, a cloud-based application system for social and labor insurance procedures, started in 2007. Subsequent upgrades of the functions of this software led to the 2016 launch of Net de Shalom (V3.4). In 2019, Shalom V5.0 was launched for even better use with the internet and a higher level of security.

FOREVER will be the first Shalom web system. This product will improve the UI/UX and be compatible with many types of devices and browsers. Another feature is even better seamless links with the products of MKSystem and other companies. The goal is to create a system that is extremely user-friendly.

Online seminars were held on a regular basis to allow people throughout Japan to learn about MKSystem products and services. Seminars that include information from current users of these products and services were very popular.







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






